### Pathway to the University of Melbourne

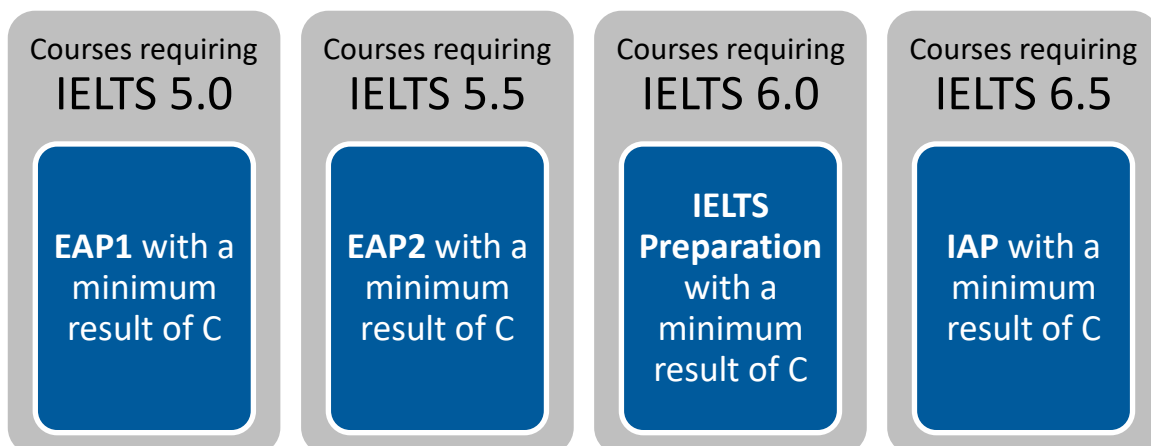
Students applying for the University of Melbourne (CRICOS 00116K) may be eligible for the University of Melbourne English Language Bridging Program.
