

# PARENT NOMINATED HOMESTAY

Finding safe, welcoming and affordable accommodation for international students can be difficult. If a parent has a trusted friend or relative in Australia who can look after their child, they may want to consider nominating them as a homestay host.

### **PROCESS**

## **STEP 1** PLEASE REGISTER

Please provide the name of the student in the host registration form.

#### STEP 2

AHN will verify if the home address is suitable for the school. AHN will seek approval from Hawthorn-Melbourne

## STEP 3

Once confirmed, a quote will be sent out to the agent/student. Once payment is received, AHN will organise an inspection and interview of the host and property.

#### STEP 4

The placement report is provided to Hawthorn-Melbourne and Agent.

### **HOST REQUIREMENTS**

The person nominated as a homestay host will need to provide the student with the support and comfort of home. They should make them feel like part of the family, give the student a warm welcome to Australia and help them settle in to their studies. As part of the Australian Homestay Network (AHN) homestay program, hosts must meet our hosting requirements which include:

- · registering with AHN, having a house inspection and in-home interview
- having a valid Working with Children Check (WWCC), this is mandatory for all residents in the household over the age of 18)
- completing AHN's online training
- providing a private bedroom for the student as well as reliable internet access in their home
- providing the student with healthy meals
- · helping the student become familiar with their new neighbourhood and understanding local customs
- offering guidance for appropriate behaviour
- assisting in monitoring the student's behaviour, welfare and school attendance
- acting as a custodian for the student
- reporting any issues and approval requests for overnight/travel requests (students are not permitted to stay out overnight
  and must return home by their set curfew times)

## WHY CHOOSE AHN FOR HOMESTAY

- coordinating airport pick-up service (fees apply)

The homestay will be assisted by AHN to ensure the ongoing safety and wellbeing of the student. Our program includes ongoing check-ins with the host and student as well as regular consultations with the school. **NOTE: All Parent Nominated Homestays must be approved by the student's school.**
